### Academic Program for Adults with Disabilities

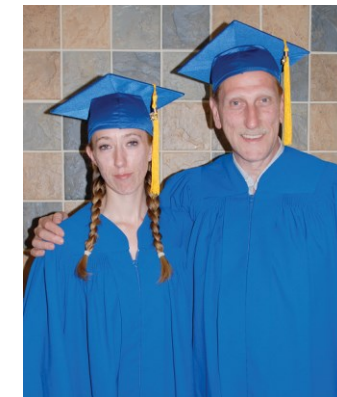
- For adults who have had a traumatic brain injury or stroke and want to improve reading, writing, speaking and math skills
