Registration Fee

- \$40/Child

All schedules will be PICK YOUR DAYS. The daily rate is based on the total number of days selected.

- 36-49 Days: \$41/day
- 22-35 Days: \$44/day
- 11-22 Days: \$49/day
- 1-10 Days: \$52/day

Drop-Ins must be requested at least 2 days in advance and will be accepted on a space availability basis for \$52/day.

• SUMMER ACADEMY •

Summer Academy is located at Sandburg Middle School. It offers a large variety of summer enrichment opportunities for students in the Robbinsdale Area Schools community.

All students enrolled in The Basement qualify for a discounted rate for Summer Academy classes based on the number of days registered at The Basement.

Registration for Summer Academy classes opens on February 28th.

• SUMMER ACTIVITIES •

The Basement is especially designed for students in middle school as they grow into responsible teens. At times, students will have the opportunity to be outside of the direct supervision of adults with clear expectations about appropriate boundaries and rules. This applies to certain times onsite, as well as some outings throughout the summer. Abuse of rules, check-in times, and set parameters will result in the loss of privileges. Attention is given to the needs of young teens and pre-teens, and at times different ages may have different boundaries in terms of supervision. We encourage students to be independent, but provide support for safety and learning.

A light breakfast and lunch are available at no additional cost. Afternoon snack is included in the daily rate.
